Rooms are always disinfected between each and every patient, instruments are properly sterilized in monitored, safe devices and anything that cannot be sterilized in these devices are properly disinfected per established guidelines. With the current pandemic, the following steps are being taken, in addition, to ensure your safety:

- Screening patients for international travel, signs or symptoms of infection when updating medical histories, or making new appointments.
- We will be disinfecting tough-point areas, door knobs, counter tops, restrooms, etc. multiple times per day.
- Hand sanitizer will be placed for your use.
- Magazines will be removed from the reception area
- Patients will be encouraged to rinse their mouth with non-alcoholic mouthwash, provided by the practice, prior to start of treatment.
